Separate sealed bids for construction of Sewer System Improvements for the Shelbyville Power, Water & Sewerage System acting on behalf of the City of Shelbyville, Tennessee will be received at the office of said Shelbyville Power, Water & Sewerage System located at 308 South Main Street, Shelbyville, Tennessee 37162 until 2:00 p.m. Central Time, Tuesday, April 15, 2025, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions for Bidders.

All bidders must be licensed general contractors as required by the Contractor's Licensing Act of 1976 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee and qualified for the type of construction being bid upon.
